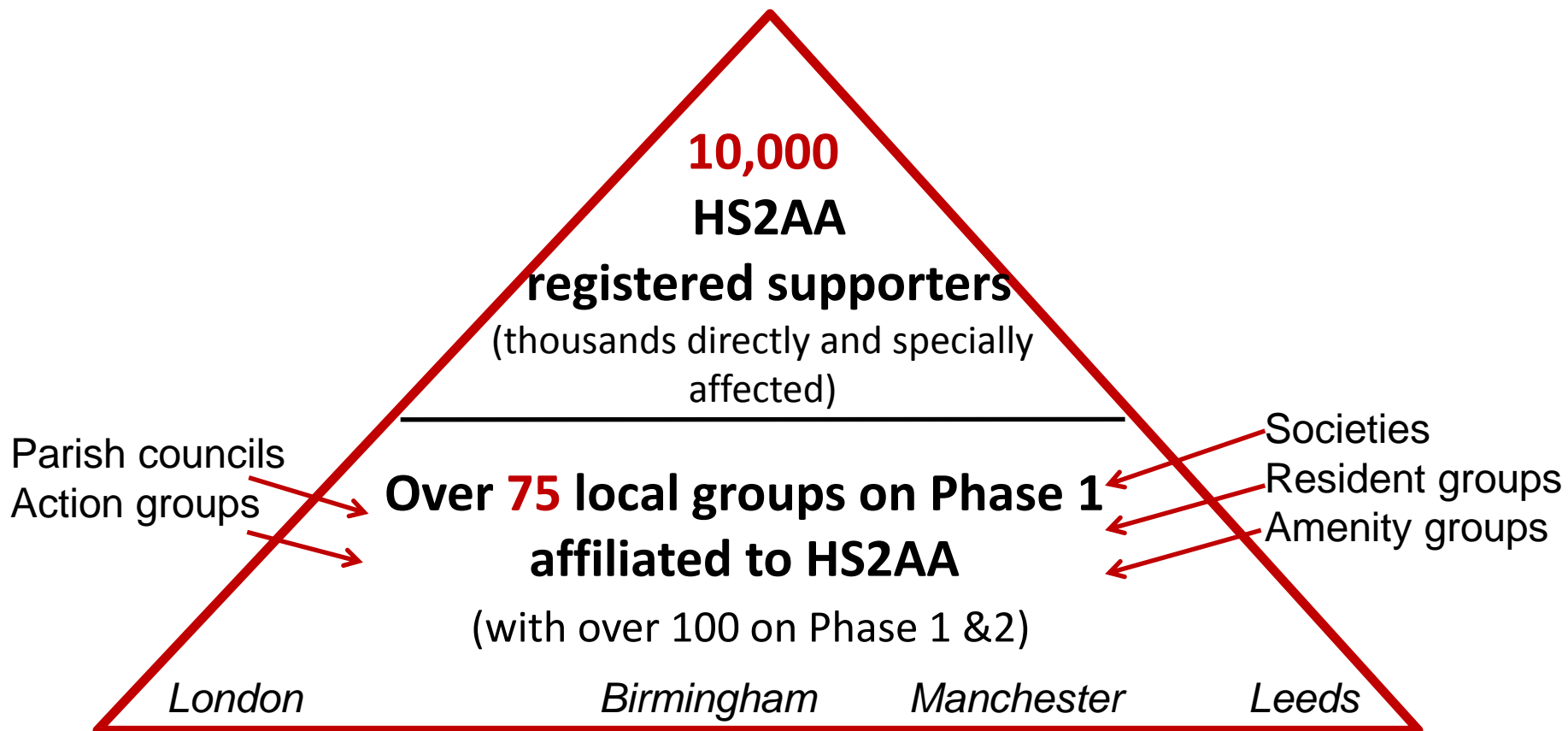


- **Incorporation date:** 19 April 2010
- **Objectives:**
 - To **question and evaluate** the economic and environmental impacts of the proposals for the HS2 rail link and to **communicate** the facts about HS2 rail link in a clear, accurate and timely manner
 - To **facilitate co-ordination** of community level organisations, specialist companies and government groups to ensure efforts are maximised without duplication and to **pool best resources and talent**
 - To **investigate and implement** ways of minimising any adverse impacts the HS2 rail link may have on **individuals, communities** and the **environment**
